 - 10 year solution
- Cost implications of temporary facility
- Board request to pursue permanent structure
 - 50 year solution

Fire Station #2 Construction Timeline

- August 9: Contractor Pre-bid conference
- August 18: Construction bid opening
- September 27: Board discussion of construction contract
- October 11: Board considers approval of construction contract
- October 12-13: Close on loan; construction can begin
- Eight month construction schedule, completion by end of FY17
