



RESOLUTION 2017-22
DESIGNATING THE TOWN MANAGER AS THE AUTHORITY TO AWARD
CONTRACT FOR THE PUBLIC FACILITIES PROJECT ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN
OF DAVIDSON PER NCGS § 143-129

WHEREAS, NCGS § 143-129 requires that the governing body formally delegate the authority to the “manager, school superintendent, chief purchasing official, or other employee the authority to award contracts, reject bids, or readvertise to receive bids on behalf of the unit.”

WHEREAS, the public facilities project will require numerous contracts for architectural, construction management, geo-technical, and other services prior to the construction contract and;

WHEREAS, North Carolina §143-64.31 stipulates that the Mini-Brooks Act does not require approval of the Board of Commissioners for contract awards and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Davidson designate the town manager to authorize service contracts up to \$925,000 for the public facilities project per the project estimate, to be reimbursed from subsequent financing when approved by the Local Government Commission.
