- » Bond, Inspections, Replacement Criteria
  - Bond: Secures Money for Improvements
  - Warranty/Inspections: 24/18 Mo. [Tree/Shrub]
  - Replacement: Continual Maintenance Req.

- 9.3 Tree Coverage & Preservation
  - » Tree Canopy Requirements (Minimum):
    - Must Preserve and/or Plant
    - Specific Planning Area Thresholds
      - Based on Canopy Study [Planning Areas]
      - Max. Preservation Contribution [50%]
    - Min. Tree Size for Plantings
  - » Flexibility New Trees Count, PIL Select Areas?

#### 9.3 Tree Removal

- » Regulates Indiv. Lots + Master Plans
- » Establishes Clear Permitting Process
  - Specifies Procedural Steps, Approval Reqs.
- » Facilitates Arborist Involvement
- » Does Not Prohibit Tree Removal

### 9.3 REMOVAL COMPARISON

#### • Current Ordinance:

- » Covers 8"+ / 12"+ Trees
- » Area Regulated:
  Setback Areas Only
- » Arborist Not Involved
- » No Fee, Generic Fine

#### Proposed Ordinance:

- » Covers 12"+ Trees
- » Area Regulated: Entire Lot
- » Arborist Closely Involved
  - Meets On-Site
  - Recommendations
  - Produces Report
- » Base Fee, Calibrated Fine?

#### 9.4 Street Tree Plantings

- » Rigorous yet Flexible [Exs. 25-30' Avg., 8' Strip]
- » Ref. Standards [Am. Std. for Nursery Stock]
- » Amended Soils, Tree Pit Requirements [New]

#### 9.5 Site Landscaping

- » Ensures Doc. Consistency
- » Est. Min. Planting Area Standards for Bldgs.
- » Minimal Adjustments

- 9.6 Parking Area Landscaping
  - » Covers Existing + New Parking Lots
- 9.7 Screening
  - » Covers Special Circumstances
  - » Eliminate DPO 4.3.1.E Redundancies
- 9.8 Installation & Maintenance Standards
  - » Covers Misc. Topics
  - » Includes New Third-Party Ref. (AmericanHort)
