Meeting was called to order at approximately 7:05p.m. by Steedman Lyles

- 1. November 15, 2016 minutes were approved.
- 2. Nicole Storey and George Berger were welcomed as new members to the board.
- 3. Update on student board position Rebecca Chaffin will remain on the board in the student space
- 4. Officer elections we made and approved as follows: Chair Marty Metzker, Vice Chair Steedman Lyles, Secretary Mary Walsh
- 5. Gary Frankhauser gave an update on Bailey Springs. He presented the updated renderings of the plan.
- 6. Steedman gave an update from Marty on the Parks and Rec Chair Committee. The committee recommended that there be a comprehensive greenway map online for all three towns. The North Meck Recreation Center was discussed as the County budgeting for it in 2018 with construction to start in 2019. However, there are a lot of variable involved and all towns need a significant presence once hearing begin. Teh Antiquity Greenway is on hold because Charlotte water is putting a water main on Hwy 115. Lake Norman Bike Fest is scheduled for May 13th at Caldwell Station and are hoping to get a sponsorship from Novant.
- 7. Leslie gave an update on the watercraft lottery and stated that a few spots were remaining and that our department was going to contact the wait-list to fill those remaining spaces.
- 8. Kathryn Spatz told the committee that Fisher Farm greenway construction through the county was going to start in February.
- 9. Kathryn gave an update on the Armour Street Park. She felt confident that an agreement would be reached for community access to the park.
- 10. South Street park was on hold with the K-8 DES/CMS expansion to take place in 2019.

The meeting adjourned to sub-committees at 8:00 pm. The next meeting is scheduled for February 21, 2017.
